A caboose has been purchased, and it will be restored in the future.

The Kankakee Railroad Museum provides an educational exhibit of Kankakee's rich railroading history. The three operating model train layouts are a favorite of the children who visit the museum. Their eyes sparkle when they see Thomas the Train on the O scale layout. They enjoy the tours of the railroad coach, trolley, and caboose. They learn about the role of the railroads in the development our national transport system.
