The Railroad Museum began in 1999 with the building of three model train layouts. A Pullman car was purchased and restored with half of the car converted into an elegant dining car. A caboose and Kankakee trolley car were added, and the historic Kankakee trolley car is being restored. The caboose is waiting for restoration.

The Railroad Museum has hosted visitors of all ages. The Pullman car has hosted dinners, brunches, birthday parties, and many community tours. Classes of school age children have been coming to enjoy the model trains and to experience what rail travel was like for their grandparents or great-grandparents.

Educational opportunities such as these are important for our community, but they do not come without a cost. Restoration work continues on the trolley and restoration of the caboose has needs to be done. Since the Museum's budget is limited, we are appealing to our friends in the community for support to preserve the railroading history of Kankakee County.
